were not sure if everything was going to fit in the car, and then we were not sure how we were going to

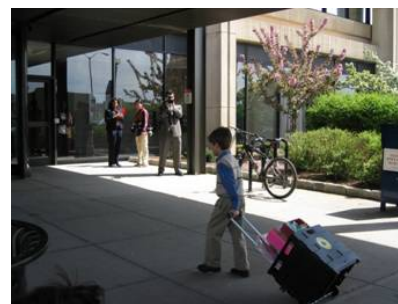
carry everything inside. But with the help of my sisters and Grandparents we did just fine.
