Bicycle Helmet Drive

We are ready to get started on our summer long project. We were asked by Jane Newman Kessler, director of Foundations at Clara Maass Medical Center, to participate in a Bicycle Helmet Drive. We have learned that each year nearly 2,000 children end up in hospitals with bicycle-related injuries, almost a third of which are traumatic injuries to the brain. The risk of death or catastrophic disability from serious head injury is obvious. Wearing a bicycle helmet can reduce a child's risk of head injury by 85%. In an effort to reduce the risk of injury to children in our community, we are conducting a summer long Bicycle Helmet Drive. These bicycle helmets will be distributed to needy children and their families that come into the emergency room
